

RESOLUTION NO. 01-11


- WHEREAS,** the Public Defender Service Corporation (PDSC) is a sub-grantee of the Stop Violence Against Women Program, funded entirely by federal monies administered by the office of the Governor of Guam; and
- WHEREAS,** a full-time "Domestic Violence Specialist" is employed and charged with administering the program's goals and objectives as set forth in the original grant application; and
- WHEREAS,** the 2010 Memorandum of Understanding between federal officials and the government of Guam is presently at the Department of Administration for processing, and will be released to the PDSC in the near future; and
- WHEREAS,** in order to continue to fulfill the program's goals, it is necessary to advance the amount of \$32,169.16 from PDSC's operations to cover expenses for the period of February through April 2011; and
- WHEREAS,** once these federal funds are released to the PDSC, this exact amount will be reimbursed to the Corporation's operations account; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED,** the Board of Trustees of the Public Defender Service Corporation, in its meeting of February 23, 2011 hereby approves the Corporation's request to advance the amount of \$32,169.16 from its operations fund to the Domestic Violence Program to cover program expenses for the period of February through April 2011.
