


RESOLUTION NO. PDSC 01-16

- WHEREAS,** the office of the Alternate Public Defender (APD), a separate division of the Public Defender Service Corporation (PDSC), was established through PDSC Board of Trustees Resolution No. 08-04; and
- WHEREAS,** the PDSC Board of Trustees approved the APD's Fiscal Year 2016 Budget Request through PDSC Resolution No. 07-15; and
- WHEREAS,** the Judicial Council of Guam subsequently approved the APD's Fiscal Year 2016 Budget Request at its meeting on March 30, 2015 through JC Resolution No. JC15-006; and
- WHEREAS,** this team-oriented, comprehensive training is critical to the planning and development of a DWI Court operating under the 10 Guiding Principles for DWI Courts; and
- WHEREAS,** teams attending the training will receive the knowledge, skills and tools to effectively implement a DWI Court in their jurisdiction; and
- WHEREAS,** the APD would like to send Attorney Eric Overton; and
- WHEREAS,** the anticipated travel cost is 50% for per diem of \$535.00, Mr. Overton will take care of airfare and lodging; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED,** The Board of Trustees of the Public Defender Service Corporation, in its meeting of October 27, 2015 hereby approves the Alternate Public Defender's request for the expenditure of \$535.00 of lapsed funds for the purposes described above, and as specified on the attachments hereto, which are made a part of this resolution.
