§11113.1 of 12 GCA authorizes the Public Defender Service Corporation (PDSC) to retain unexpended appropriations beginning with Fiscal Year 2000, and to carry these funds over into succeeding fiscal years; and

WHEREAS,

the PDSC Board of Trustees adopted Resolution No. 99-07 requiring Board approval for the budgeting of and/or spending authorization(s) for these lapsed funds; and

WHEREAS,

through sound fiscal responsibility and frugal measures of spending prior year's appropriations, the PDSC continues to have lapsed funds available in Fiscal Year 2017; and

WHEREAS,

the PDSC management team has determined that it will be beneficial to have an attorney attend the 2017 Appellate Defender Training (ADT) in New Orleans, Louisiana from January 19 - 22, 2017; and

WHEREAS,

during the ADT, participants will analyze fact and law issues, develop case theories and themes, and incorporate them into their motion, brief, or writ drafting; and

WHEREAS,

the request to attend the training is estimated at \$3,148.00 – covering training registration (\$825), airfare (\$1,387.55), per diem (\$936); and

WHEREAS,

the attorney that attends ADT must by on the Appellate Panel; and

RESOLVED,

The Board of Trustees of the Public Defender Service Corporation, in its meeting of October 18, 2016 hereby approves the Corporation's request for the expenditure of \$3,148.55 of lapsed funds to have an attorney attend the 2017 Appellate Defender Training (ADT) in New Orleans, Louisiana from January 19-22, 2017.
