RESOLUTION NO. PDSC 03-17

- WHEREAS,** §11113.1 of 12 GCA authorizes the Public Defender Service Corporation (PDSC) to retain unexpended appropriations beginning with Fiscal Year 2000, and to carry these funds over into succeeding fiscal years; and
- WHEREAS,** the PDSC Board of Trustees adopted Resolution No. 99-07 requiring Board approval for the budgeting of and/or spending authorization(s) for these lapsed funds; and
- WHEREAS,** through sound fiscal responsibility and frugal measures of spending prior year's appropriations, the PDSC and APD continues to have lapsed funds available in Fiscal Year 2017; and
- WHEREAS,** the PDSC management team has determined that it will be beneficial to organize a legal clinic with trainers Laurie Shanks and Terry Kindlon for APD and PDSC attorneys to attend from April 6 – 8, 2017; and
- WHEREAS,** the request to organize the training is estimated at \$16,000.00; which will cover airfare for the trainers (\$10,000.00), trainers' hotel accommodations (\$1,000.00), venue rental for 3-days (\$5,000); and
- WHEREAS,** the PDSC and APD will split the cost for the total training at a 60/40 split between both organizations; and
- RESOLVED,** The Board of Trustees of the Public Defender Service Corporation, in its meeting of December 20, 2016 hereby approves the Corporation's request for the expenditure of \$16,000 of lapsed funds (\$6,000 from PDSC and \$4,000 from APD) to have trainers Laurie Shanks and Terry Kindlon conduct a legal clinic for APD/PDSC attorneys from April 6 – 8, 2017.
