

RESOLUTION NO. PDSC 04-15


- WHEREAS,** the office of the Alternate Public Defender (APD), a separate division of the Public Defender Service Corporation (PDSC), was established through PDSC Board of Trustees Resolution No. 08-04; and
- WHEREAS,** the PDSC Board of Trustees approved the APD's Fiscal Year 2015 Budget Request through Board Resolution No. 14-14 ; and
- WHEREAS,** the Judicial Council of Guam subsequently approved the APD's Fiscal Year 2015 Budget Request at its duly-noticed meeting on July 17, 2014; and
- WHEREAS,** due to continued budgetary constraints, the APD did not express their need for three (3) computer workstations (to replace obsolete ones); and
- WHEREAS,** the APD additionally wishes to promote greater efficiency and effectiveness with the procurement of two (2) iPads for official use by its attorneys and/or investigators; and
- WHEREAS,** a preliminary price quote of \$7,000 for three (3) computer workstations, and \$1,500 for two (2) iPads has been obtained by the Public Defender Service Corporation MIS Administrator; and
- WHEREAS,** a review of the APD's finances with regards to lapsed funds revealed that sufficient monies exist to cover these expenses; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED,** The Board of Trustees of the Public Defender Service Corporation, in its duly-noticed meeting of October 28, 2014, hereby approves the Alternate Public Defender's request for the expenditure of \$8,500.00 of lapsed funds for the purpose of purchasing three (3) computer workstations and two (2) iPads.
