- WHEREAS,** the office of the Alternate Public Defender (APD), a separate division of the Public Defender Service Corporation (PDSC), was established through PDSD Board of Trustees Resolution No. 08-04; and
- WHEREAS,** the PDSC Board of Trustees approved the APD's Fiscal Year 2018 Budget Request through PDSC Resolution No. 04-17; and
- WHEREAS,** the Judicial Council of Guam subsequently approved the APD's Fiscal Year 2018 Budget Request at its meeting on May 3, 2018 through JC Resolution No. JC18-009; and
- WHEREAS,** due to Judiciary of Guam withholding ten percent (10%) of APD'S FY2018 budget, management has determined a budget shortfall for FY2018 expenses in the amount of \$9,844.50; and
- WHEREAS,** the anticipated expenses will affect the timely payment of vendor payables for goods and/or services received by APD due to its budget shortfall; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED,** The Board of Trustees of the Public Defender Service Corporation, in its meeting of August 14, 2018, hereby approves the Alternate Public Defender's request to use lapsed funds for expenditures incurred in FY2018 in the amount of **\$10,000.00** for the purposes described above.
