


**BEFORE THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

RELATIVE TO THE USAGE OF PDSC LAPSED FUNDS  
TO PURCHASE A REPLICATION SERVER**

**Resolution No. 11-12**


- WHEREAS,** the PDSC has been operating for over ten years utilizing the 2003 Small Business Server for the operational needs and requirements of the agency; and
- WHEREAS,** the PDSC recently purchased the 2011 Small Business Server with the intent of transferring all the data stored on the 2003 Server to the 2011 Server and utilizing the 2003 Server as the backup; and
- WHEREAS,** the 2003 Server crashed on May 01, 2012 due to hardware failure and resulted in the corruption of the licenses previously stored; and
- WHEREAS,** the corruption of the licenses required the Management Information Systems' section to work extended hours to manually reconfigure and install the licenses of each employee; and
- WHEREAS,** the unavailability of data stored on the server hampered the overall operations of the Corporation; and
- WHEREAS,** the 2011 Server is now being utilized as the main and sole server of the Corporation; and
- WHEREAS,** data collected, stored and shared is undeniably imperative to the success of the Public Defender Service Corporation and a large amount of data is stored electronically, it is in the best interest of the Corporation to have a replication server backup system for all data in order to safeguard against potential data loss from a natural disaster, theft or hardware failure; therefore be it
- RESOLVED,** by the PDSC Board of Trustees at its regular meeting, hereby approves the usage of PDSC lapsed funds, with a cap of \$12,000.00, to purchase a replication server.
