


**BEFORE THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

RELATIVE TO THE USE OF
ALTERNATE PUBLIC DEFENDER'S LAPSED FUNDS
FOR THE UPGRADE OF WORKSTATIONS AND SOFTWARE**

RESOLUTION NO. 18-16

- WHEREAS,** the office of the Alternate Public Defender (APD), a separate division of the Public Defender Service Corporation (PDSC), was established through PDSC Board of Trustees Resolution No. 08-04; and
- WHEREAS,** the PDSC Board of Trustees approved the APD's Fiscal Year 2016 Budget Request through PDSC Resolution No. 07-15; and
- WHEREAS,** the Judicial Council of Guam subsequently approved the APD's Fiscal Year 2016 Budget Request at its meeting on March 30, 2015 through JC Resolution No. JC15-006; and
- WHEREAS,** through sound fiscal responsibility and frugal measures of spending prior year's appropriations, the APD continues to have lapsed funds available for Fiscal Year 2016; and
- WHEREAS,** the APD has certain operational needs that include software upgrades to Microsoft Office 2016 for fifteen (15) licenses that will replace the obsolete Microsoft Office 2003 Version that is currently being used at APD in the amount of \$6,500.00; and
- WHEREAS,** computer hardware upgrades are necessary for three (3) attorney workstations, in the amount of \$8,000.00, that will include dual monitor systems to replace computer workstations that are no longer under warranty for service as well as parts and are deemed obsolete; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED,** the Board of Trustees of the Public Defender Service Corporation, in its meeting of April 26, 2016, hereby approves the Corporation's request for software and hardware upgrades in the amount of \$14,500.00 of APD's lapsed funds to improve operational efficiencies at the Alternate Public Defender.
