



**BEFORE THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES  
OF THE PUBLIC DEFENDER SERVICE CORPORATION  
RELATIVE TO  
REDUCING MILEAGE REIMBURSEMENT (LOCAL TRAVEL) COSTS**


**RESOLUTION NO. PDSC 95-02**

- WHEREAS, The Public Defender Service Corporation in a prior audit was instructed to convert from a system of set sums for mileage to a system of mileage payable at \$.60 per mile;
- WHEREAS, The Government of Guam is in a fiscal crisis and the Governor has ordered all executive agencies to reduce mileage expenditures to \$.30 per mile; and
- WHEREAS, The Superior Court of Guam does not pay mileage because it has motor vehicles of its own to use, so the Public Defender Service Corporation is now one of the only agencies paying \$.60 per mile; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED, The Board of Trustees of the Public Defender Service Corporation, in its meeting of June 13, 1995, directed the Executive Director to reduce the expenditure for mileage expenses to \$.30 per mile, effective June 01, 1995.
