The Board of Trustees of the Public Defender Service Corporation, in its meeting of February 18, 1999, directed the Executive Director to provide mileage reimbursements to PDSC employees who utilize their personally-owned vehicles for business purposes, at prevailing rates established by the Internal Revenue Service; be it further

RESOLVED,

This Resolution shall be made retroactive to February 1, 1999.
