LAW ENFORCEMENT PERSONNEL AT THE PUBLIC
DEFENDER SERVICE CORPORATION AND THE
ALTERNATE PUBLIC DEFENDER**

RESOLUTION NO. PDSC 03-23

WHEREAS, on January 18, 2022, the Governor of Guam issued Executive Order No. 2022-01, which raised the base pay of executive branch law enforcement officers by 18% but which did not affect the Investigators at both the PDSC and APD; and

WHEREAS, in response to the executive branch law enforcement pay increase, the PDSC’s Human Resources (“HR”) Division reviewed the law enforcement officer pay within both organizations; and

WHEREAS, at the PDSC Board of Trustees Meeting of April 26, 2022 the PDSC’s Administrative Director presented PDSC’s budget that included a cost analysis of a seven percent (7%) increase for law enforcement pay and a six percent (6%) increase for non-law enforcement pay; and

WHEREAS, at the April 26, 2022 Board of Trustees meeting and with the approval of the Fiscal Year Budgets for PDSC and APD, through Resolution No. 02-22, which included an increase (7%) increase for law enforcement pay and a six percent (6%) increase for non-law enforcement pay; it is now therefore

RESOLVED that the Public Defender Service Corporations’ HR division will adjust the pays scales, retroactive to October 1, 2022, for a seven percent (7%) increase for law enforcement pay and a six percent (6%) increase for non-law enforcement pay for both PDSC and APD.
