# BEFORE THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE PUBLIC DEFENDER SERVICE CORPORATION RELATIVE TO THE APPROVAL OF THE PUBLIC DEFENDER SERVICE CORPORATION, CIVIL LAW CENTER AND ALTERNATE PUBLIC DEFENDER FISCAL YEAR 2025 BUDGET REQUESTS

#### **RESOLUTION NO. PDSC 07-24**

- WHEREAS, Chapter 11 of Title 12 Guam Code Annotated established the Public Defender Service Corporation (PDSC) in order to provide effective legal aid and assistance to individuals on Guam who are unable to afford counsel; and
- WHEREAS, on April 21, 2004, through Board Resolution No. 08-04, the Board of Trustees created the Alternate Public Defender (APD) to receive cases which the PDSC must withdraw from due to conflicts of interest as established on the Corporation's General Administration Standard Operating Procedures No. 001-FY2004 and 002-FY2004; and
- WHEREAS, in order to fulfill the mandates of Chapter 11, Title 12 Guam Code Annotated, the PDSC requires legislative appropriations through the budgetary process established for each fiscal year; and
- WHEREAS, the PDSC and APD presented their respective Fiscal Year 2025 Budget Requests of \$7,012,231 (PDSC); \$1,829,419 (APD); and \$1,031,212 (CLC) respectively to the Board of Trustees on April 25, 2023; and
- WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees finds such respective budget requests appropriate and adequate to carry out the PDSC and APD's mission relative to criminal defense in Fiscal Year 2025; and
- WHEREAS, the Board of Trustee, after making the Civil Law Center (CLC) a permanent division of the Public Defender Service Corporation finds appropriate the budget amount presented to cover civil matters provided by the Civil Law Center in Fiscal Year 2025; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Fiscal Year 2025 PDSC, APD, and CLC Budget Summary was reviewed, discussed, and considered for approval:

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Fiscal Year 2025 Public Defender Service Corporation, which includes a separate section for the Civil Law Center, and the Alternate Public Defender Budget Summary as shown in the attached EXHIBITS "A", "B" and "C" is hereby APPROVED by the Board of Trustees for submission to the I Liheslaturan Guahan and shall be subject to legislative appropriation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chief Justice and Executive Director of the Public Defender Service Corporation are authorized to finalize all remaining supporting documentation relative to the Fiscal Year 2025 Public Defender and Alternate Public Defender budgets consistent with the Budget Summary marked in EXHIBITS "C", "D" and "E" and need not present such documentation to the Board of Trustees for further approval.
