#### IV. PROOF OF DUE NOTICE OF MEETING

"Notice of Public Meeting" was published in The Guam Daily Post on Tuesday, January 21, 2025 and January 24, 2025, and posted on Government of Guam's Public Notices Portal.

#### V. <u>APPROVAL OF MINUTES</u>

Chief Justice Torres stated they will proceed with the approval of the minutes of the regular board meeting of December 31, 2024.

Motion to adopt the minutes was made by Trustee Whitman and seconded by Presiding Judge Lamorena. Approved by acclamation.

#### VI. OLD BUSINESS

## A. <u>FINANCIAL STATUS UPDATE/ALLOTMENT RELEASES (PDSC, APD, CLC)</u>

CFO Moreno stated that PDSC and APD are operating at 89% and 90%, respectively. A January allotment of \$756,316 was received for PDSC. A second allotment is expected the week of this meeting. The Civil Law Center also received a January allotment of \$72,428. Money from the General Fund will be used to cover expenses starting in January 2025. Remaining ARPA funds will be used to reimburse PDSC for funds used the COVID-19 pandemic. Said expenses have yet to be calculated and will be provided at a later date.

Payments have yet to be received for invoices issued for ICJR for \$30,476 and STOP for \$13,532. A Release of Claim has been filed for an outstanding balance of \$16,012 from March 2024. Invoices for October to December 2024 for \$18,914 per month have also been issued. An invoice of \$832.50 was also issued to Westcare for December 2024, but money has yet to be received.

#### B. REPORT FROM PDSC EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

ED Hattori stated that PDSC has 1,954 pre-trial cases which include about 830 bench warrants. They continue to monitor and file EM packets.

He continued that PDSC plans to meet with trainers for its upcoming 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary celebration where CLE credits will be offered. They plan on extending this training to the private attorney panel. He also welcomed AD Ngata to PDSC.

#### C. <u>REPORT FROM APD MAN</u>AGING ATTORNEY

MA Gayle reported that APD received 66 felonies, 32 misdemeanors and 16 juvenile cases for 1<sup>st</sup> quarter. FY2024 ended with 515 cases total. They have 639 pre-trial cases. Also included in their stats are EM packets and motions for release. She continued that 37% of misdemeanor cases and 43% of felony cases close at an average of 0-5 months.

#### D. <u>REPORT FROM CLC MANAGING ATTORNEY</u>

MA Hinkle-Sanchez stated that CLC and EJC stats were not included in this meeting's packet. She clarified that while their Veterans Program grant shows zero stats, they continue to participate in outreach events. There were 92 clients serviced under EJC, 53 of which were new cases and 26 were closed. They serviced another 145 clients, 116 of which were new and closed 97 cases. Thirteen new cases were opened under TAC.

MA Hinkle-Sanchez shared that Senator Calvo reached out to her regarding probate services. She will soon issue a letter to the Trustees regarding this matter. Chief Justice Torres stated they will await the letter to re-evaluate the need and scope of services of CLC.

#### E. SIXTH AMENDMENT CENTER PROJECTS

ED Hattori stated that PDSC has met with the Judiciary on the proposed legislation and will likely meet them once more to finalize. Chief Justice Torres added they will seek sponsorship once they decide to move forward, ideally by the next budget cycle.

#### VII. <u>NEW BUSINESS</u>

#### A. DONATED LEAVE BANK POLICY AND RESOLUTION

AD Ngata stated the Resolution has been amended to reflect the ED and MAs having final approval of all requests. Presiding Judge Lamorena confirmed that these changes were established at the last meeting. Chief Justice Torres confirmed he will sign the Resolution.

## B. <u>APD MANAGING ATTORNEY ANA MARIA GAYLE'S EVALUATION</u> <u>RESOLUTION</u>

The proposed merit bonus owed to MA Gayle is estimated at 3.5% of her base pay.

Motion to approve MA Gayle's merit bonus made by Presiding Judge Lamorena and seconded by Trustee Whitman. Approved by acclamation.

Chief Justice Torres clarified that while MA Gayle was not hired as a classified employee, she has vested rights in classified service to return as an Attorney IV in the event she is no longer a Managing Attorney.

#### VIII. PUBLIC DISUCSSION

#### X. ADJOURNMENT AND NEXT MEETING DATE


